Griffin-Spalding County School System Educator Hall of Fame

Exemplary educators have been associated with the Griffin-Spalding County School System since its founding in 1953. The school system wants to honor those who have gone beyond the call of duty to further the education of students in Spalding County by inducting them into the Griffin-Spalding Educator Hall of Fame. This is an opportunity to recognize those who have made outstanding and significant contributions to students, staff, parents and the community through their employment in the Griffin-Spalding County School System. Nominate a current or former GSCS educator to possibly be a part of the third class inducted into this elite Hall of Fame.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Former Griffin-Spalding County School System employees who worked for a minimum of 10 years with the system are eligible to be nominated for the Hall of Fame.
- Eligible persons would need to be retired or resigned at least five years from the Griffin-Spalding County School System before being nominated.
- Nominations submitted will keep eligibility for three years and would automatically be considered by the selection panel for each of those years.

*Please note: Those inducted into the Educator Hall of Fame, if living, are expected to attend and participate in the induction recognition. They will be expected to provide a photograph for installation in the Hall of Fame. If the inductee is unable to attend, a family member or representative will be expected to attend and participate accordingly in the Induction Ceremony.
